Based on Burlington's interpretation of the Ecosphere's risk ranking criteria, the new drilling pit will be a lined pit as detailed in Burlington's Revised Drilling / Workover Pit Construction / Operation Procedures dated November 11, 2004 on file at the NMOCDC office. A portion of the vent/flare pit will be designed to manage fluids and that portion will be lined as per the risk ranking criteria. Burlington Resources anticipates closing these pits according to the Drilling / Workover Pit Closure Procedure dated August 2, 2004 on file at the NMOCDC office.
