Plug & Abandonment Report

Summary:

Notified BLM on 10/18/04

10/18/04MOL and RU.

10/19/04 Well pressures: 0# on casing, 0# on tubing, light blow on bradenhead. Lay relief lines to pit. Blow down well. ND wellhead. NU BOP, test. PU and TIH with 77 joints 2-3/8" A+ tubing workstring. Tag existing CIBP at 2410'. Connect pump line to the bradenhead valve. Pressure test bradenhead annulus to 300#, held OK for 10 minutes. Pressure test casing to 500# for 10 minutes, held OK.

Plug #1 with CIBP at 2410', spot 44 sxs Type III cement (58 cf) inside 7" casing above CIBP up to 2148' to isolate the Fruitland Coal formation. PUH to 912'.

Plug #2 with 29 sxs Type III cement (38 cf) inside casing from 912' to 739' to cover the Kirtland top. PUH to 344'.

Plug #3 with 62 sxs Type III cement (82 cf) inside the 7" casing from 344' to surface, circulate good cement out the casing valve.

TOH and LD tubing. Shut in well and WOC.

Dig out and cut off wellhead. Found cement down 15' in 7" casing. Mix 20 sxs Type III cement to fill casing and to install the P&A marker. RD & MOL.
