
Energen Resources recently finished a pay add and down hole commingling operations on the subject well. In accordance with the approved Administrative Order, the supervisor of the Aztec District Office of the NMOCD shall determine the proper production allocation.

Prior to commingling operations, the Mesaverde was producing at a stabilized rate of about 120 MCFPD and about 0 BOPD. The Pictured Cliffs was added in September of 2004 and the well was returned to production on October 14, 2004. The well has stabilized at a rate of about 150 MCPD and about 0 BOPD. The following allocation is recommended (see attached production plot):
