Dear Mr. Hayden:

Energen Resources recently finished a pay add and down hole commingling operations on the subject well. In accordance with the approved Administrative Order, the supervisor of the Aztec District Office of the NMOCD shall determine the proper production allocation.

Prior to commingling operations, the Wildcat Gallup and Basin Dakota were producing at a commingled stabilized rate of 95 MCFD & 1 BOPD. The Mesaverde was added in January and February 2004. The well was returned to production on February 16, 2004. The well currently has a stabilized rate of 260 MCFD & 1 BOPD. The following allocation is recommended for this triple commingled well:
