DETAILS OF WORK

Notice of Intention to Abandon Well, Form 9-331a, was approved May 15, 1952. Well was permanently plugged and abandoned as follows: 1. Plugged hole with solid cement from bottom of hole to 1095 feet; 2. Plugged hole with solid cement from 480 to 415 feet; 3. Filled hole with 12 pound mud from 1095 to 480 feet and from 415 to 65 feet; 4. May 13, 1952, plugged hole with solid cement from 65 feet to surface; 5. Erected 4' pipe marker and restored ground level to original contours as per regulations.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
