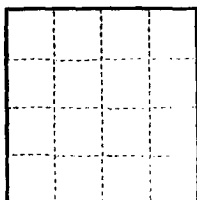

DETAILS OF WORK

5-30-54 TD 6573. J.H. Oak & Co. contractors. Spotted 25 sz. cnt. by Halliburton from 6573 to 6444'. Mudded hole 6444' to 6058', placed cement plug by Halliburton 6058 to 5933'. Shot 7" casing off at 1300' by Dia-Log. Recovered 1300' 7" OD casing. Halliburton pumped 50 sz. cement 5933' to 1300'. Mudded hole 1300' to 10'. Placed cement plug from 10' to surface. Cement 7' piece of 4" pipe in surface leaving 4' of pipe above surface for marker. Well plugged and abandoned June 2, 1954 at 12:00 Noon.

Following casing left in hole.

10-3/4" - 152' from surface to 171' RKB
7" - 4741' from 1317' RKB to 6058' RKB.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
