DETAILS OF WORK

Well has been drilled to a total depth of 6990 feet with rotary tools. As reported in our Notice of Intention to Change Plans, of September 29, 1953, four drill stem tests were run over the Fruitland and Pictured Cliffs formations with no commercial show of oil or gas. Seven drill stem tests were run over the Mesaverde formation with no commercial show of oil or gas. DST #5, microns; DST #6, 6540-6545; DST #7, 6544-6700; DST #8, 9, & 10, microns; DST #11, 6682-6845.

It is now proposed to drill the well to an approximate depth of 9500 feet to test the Dakota and Harrison formations.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
