The subject well as P&A'd on 10/6/09. At the onsite inspection for the Final Abandonment Notice (FAN) the BLM requested that the older of two cathodic ground beds be closed and the powerline on location be removed. Plans are to plug this CP well and leave the newer CP well, but the powerline needs to stay in place since the pole supplies power for the Hale #301. Therefore we are requesting an exception to removing the pole on this location, but we will would like to have the FAN approved and this well removed from Burlington Resources's Bond. The powerline will be removed once the Hale 301 which it services is P&A'd.

This well cannot be FANed until electric line is removed from location
