Next week, the week of March 7th, High Plains will have its pumper flow the well to determine if treatment with paraffin solvent and diesel has removed blockage so that oil production can resume. If not, the well will be shut-in until the end of April, or whenever thereafter that access is possible over the dirt roads from St. Hwy. 197 and the well. Then, a horizontal lateral is to be drilled approximately 2300 feet southwest from the openhole in the well and the well will be completed as an oil well in whatever fractures are intersected in the Gallup oil producing sands.
