Reference is made to the following:

(a) your application (**administrative SD application reference No. pTGW11-21353004**) submitted to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (the Division) in Santa Fe, New Mexico on August 1, 2011; and

(b) the Division's records pertinent to your request.

Energen Resources Corporation [OGRID 162928] (Energen) has requested to simultaneously dedicate an existing standard gas spacing unit consisting of the S/2 Section 27, Township 32 North, Range 4 West in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool (71629), to:

(a) its proposed Caracas 27B Well No. 16H (API No. 30-039-31056) (the proposed well), a horizontal gas well to be drilled from a surface location 1044 feet from the South line and 748 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 26, Township 32N, Range 4W, to point of penetration of the Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, 1033 feet from the South line and 100 feet
