

Dear Mr. Lovato:



XTO plans to produce the commingled gas through a central compressor, thus lowering operating expenses and extending the economic life of the wells. This increases the ultimate recoveries on all leases. The anticipated allocated fuel production and fuel usage for the compressor is noted in the attachments.

Each well will be equipped with allocation meters that will be maintained by XTO Energy in accordance with State and Federal Regulations (Onshore Order No. 5). Produced liquids will not be surface commingled.
