
**Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\***

Staining of soil was visible near wellhead. Stuffing box leak was determined as the cause of stained soil. Stained soil was excavated and taken to landfarm to remediate.

**Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\***

An area near the wellhead and projecting NE of wellhead was excavated. The total amount of soil removed was 6000 cubic feet/220 cubic yards of impacted soil. A large stockpile of soil to the east of the wellhead was also tested using 5 point composite and passed standards. This soil was spread thinly on the east side of the location.
