Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken * **A ConocoPhillips Company employee discovered a produced water spill of approximately 70 BBL at the San Juan 30-6 #431 on 5/13/08. The release was due to a tank leak that resulted from corrosion. Upon discovery, the well was shut in and a water hauler pulled the remaining fluids out of the berm and production tanks.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **All of the spilled fluids were contained within the berm, and approximately 60 BBL were recovered. The affected area will be raked and monitored to determine if further remediation is necessary. To prevent reoccurrence, the Asset and Operating Integrity group has performed an inspection of the tank.**
