


Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* Oil was changed on compressor by mechanic on 2/9/2012 at 10 am. When unit was restarted, two dump valves on suction scrubber were left open thereby allowing gas to release to the BGT. Valves were closed and well is producing.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

The gas released dissipated into the atmosphere, so no clean-up action was possible.
