Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* **On the afternoon of 2-5-08, a ConocoPhillips Company MSO (lease operator) discovered that a natural gas release had occurred at the FC State Com #16, due to a underground flowline leak, most probably due to corrosion. All natural gas was released to the atmosphere, as well as approximately 5 gal of produced water released to the ground. Upon discovery, the well was shut in. A One-Call has been made in order to excavate and replace the line.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\* **All natural gas was released to the atmosphere, as well as approximately 5 gal of produced water released to the ground. Upon One-Call clearance to dig, the line will be replaced.**
