Established an injection rate down the 4-1/2" casing with 20 bbls of water at 4 BPM and 0#. Pumped 116 sx (136 9 cu.ft) of Cl "B" cement with 60 ball seaters. The first 20 sx contained 1/4 #/sk celloflake and the first 80 sx contained 2% CaCl₂. Final pressure was 750 psi SI the well

4/26/12 Cutoff the casing and bradenhead and found the cement top in the annulus at 40'. Ran 1" poly pipe to 40' and cemented with 10 sx (11.8 cu.ft.) of Cl "B" neat cement. Filled the annulus and topped off the 4-1/2" casing. Installed the P&A marker
