Describe Cause:

May 19, 2000

Caulkins Oil Company called for a water truck to haul water from 400 bbl frac tank at Breech "C" 144, sec. 12-26N-6W, to reserve pit at Reuter 344-E, sec. 22-26N-6W. Orders were given to empty this tank so that it could be moved. The truck driver went to Breech "C" 144-E, sec. 12-26N-6W. When the driver arrived at this location she called in to verify tank and location number with Bloomfield office. The call was disconnected during conversation due to phone system malfunction. The driver proceeded to haul tank for disposal to reserve pit at Reuter 344-E. Driver dumped one 80 bbl load of drip condensate into reserve pit at Reuter 344-E, went back to Breech "C" 144-E, emptied tank, and was in transit to dump remaining condensate to reserve pit when Caulkins Oil Company pumper discovered what had happened. The second load of drip was taken back to Breech "C" 144-E and put back into tank.

I notified Charlie Perian with NMOCD and Jim Lavato with BLM and gave a verbal detailed explanation for cause of loss at 8:00 a. m. on May 17, 2000.

Necessary remedial action was discussed with Denny Foust at the Aztec NMOCD. Decision was made to spray reserve pit with OXY-1 chemical to neutralize contaminated area of reserve pit. Treated May 19, 2000.
