RE: Release Of Operator Bond Period of Liability for UMU 28-14 gas well

Dear Operator:

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Surface Protection Specialist or Natural Resource Specialist accompanied by the UMU Representative(s) and the BIA Realty Specialists and operator representative Lee Robbins of Walsh Engineering visited the gas well site named UMU 28-14 on April 24, 2012. This well tapped the Indian Mineral estate beneath Mineral Agreement #751-88-0001 having surface expression as an above ground marker in Section 28, T. 31N., R14W., San Juan County, New Mexico. The associated API number is 30-045-28213. The wellbore Request for approval to abandon (NOI) with plugging procedures was approved December 16, 2003. The Subsequent Report (SR) for wellbore abandonment was approved November 2, 2004. The Final Abandonment Notice (FAN) indicating operator verification that the surface is contoured to blend with surrounding terrain, equipment is removed and surface reclaimed has growth of desirable vegetation at 70% of surrounding undisturbed lands was received by the BLM-SJRA on May 29, 2012. The Final Abandonment of the surface was found acceptable by the BIA as indicated in the attached letter dated April 26, 2012 and received April 30, 2012.

The BLM has determined that the period of liability with regards to this well is hereby

terminated and the bond for this well may be released by the BIA. If the bond covering this well is an *individual* well bond, you may seek release of funds from the BIA-SU Agency at the following address:
