**Production from this well has decreased substantially due to coal fines. We plan to construct a water pit 50' L x 40' W x 10' D (lined w/ min. 8 mil plastic) and a unlined flare pit w/ drainage to water pit. Pit will be fenced until recalimed and reseeded to approved BLM specifications.**

1. Cleaning out the well bore with air to TD 3420' KB
2. Cavitate from 3050' to 3420'
3. Run 5 1/2" pre-perforated, tapped, & plugged liner (6spf) set @ 3420' +/- Total liner lenth 445' +/-
4. Top of liner @ 2975'. No cement
5. Run 2 3/8" production tubing. Set @ +/- 3400'
8. Run 1 1/2" downhole sucker rod pump & rods
9. Return well to production

**Proposed work is scheduled to begin 5/15/05 and after sundry is approved.**

## **Bureau of Land Management Conditions of Approval:**

- 2) If this well is located in a Specially Designated Area (SDA), compliance with the appropriate seasonal closure requirements will be necessary.**
- 3) Pits must be lined with an impervious material at least 12 mils thick. The pit must be fenced on three (3) sides during workover operations and on the 4<sup>th</sup> side after the rig moves off location. Pits must be closed within 90 days of completion of the workover operations. Prior to closing the pit the liner must be cut off at mud level.**
