On July 13, 2006, CDX RIO, LLC, submitted Applications for Permit to Drill (APD) for the Jicarilla 151 No. 2F and Jicarilla C No. 1M wells. There has been no action taken on this APD, as of this date. This APD was filed prior to EnerVest taking Record Title and Operatorship of CDX Rio, Inc. interests. At that time, the APD is hereby returned with no further action taken. If you wish to drill these wells at some later date, you must file another application for permit to drill.



If any surface disturbance was conducted, you must file your plans for reclamation with the Jicarilla BIA office. We recommend the bond remain in place until the surface reclamation is complete.

Under 43 CFR 3165.3, you may request an Administrative Review of any instructions, orders, or decisions issued by the Authorized Officer. Such a request, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, P.O. Box 27115, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87502-0115. Such a request will not result in a suspension of the instructions, orders, or decisions unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from the instructions, orders, or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 et. Seq.
