
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Water Transfer Pump Engine starter relay failed, allowing the pumping unit to continue filling the water tank above normal levels allowing 7bbls of produced water to overflow. The pumping unit was shut-off immediately and water trucks called to location. 5bbls of produced water was recovered.
