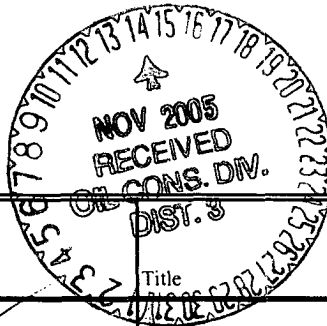

Report of CSG Leak Repair

13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operation (clearly state all pertinent details, including estimated starting date of any proposed work and approximate duration thereof. If the proposal is to deepen directionally or recompleat horizontally, give subsurface locations and measured and true vertical depths of all pertinent markers and zones. Attach the Bond under which the work will be performed or provide the Bond No. on file with BLM/BIA. Required subsequent reports shall be filed within 30 days following completion of the involved operations. If the operation results in a multiple completion or recompleat in a new interval, a Form 3160-4 shall be filed once testing has been completed. Final Abandonment Notices shall be filed only after all requirements, including reclamation, have been completed, and the operator has determined that the site is ready for final inspection.

Reference is made to telephone conversations between Matt Halbert, BLM, and Cherry Hlava, BP, on November 1st and 2nd, concerning required notification to BLM before beginning casing leak repair operations. On 08/22/05 BP commenced operations to add pay within the Mesaverde formation and encountered CSG leak between 3880' - 3906'. Reference Sundry Report of 10/24/2005. Both BP's field representative on location and engineer overseeing the project were new to the area and not aware of the regulations concerning notification prior to performing casing leak repairs. Both have now been made aware of the requirement and well work procedures now contain the provision to notify appropriate regulatory agencies prior to commencement of casing repairs.
