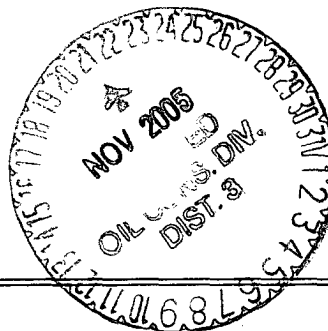

Tag cement @3065'. 11/06/05 Rig up mud loggers and drill with 6 1/4" bit, open hole to 3500'. 11/10/05 Ran 5 1/2", 15.50#, J-55 LT&C liner, top @ 3038', bottom @ 3498'. No cement or pressure testing required on 5 1/2" liner.
