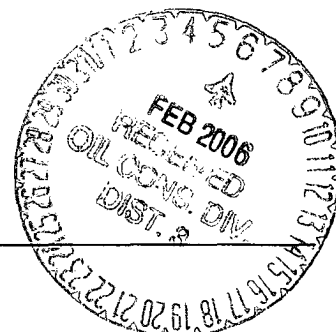

13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

Western Minerals removed the 1-1/4" tubing and installed 2-3/8" tubing.

Heavy scale was found on the 1-1/4" tubing starting at 4700'. Ran 2-3/8" tubing and cleaned out to PBTD5344' with air. Ran casing scraper and then set RBP at 5017'. Loaded the 4.5" casing with 2% KCl and then pressure tested to 750#, held OK for 5 minutes.

Treated Mesaverde perforations with 1500 gallons 15% HC Acid under a packer at 5013'.

Pulled packer and cleaned out the scale and sand for 3 days. Blew well clean.

Land 161 joints 2-3/8" tubing at 5208' with SN at 5209' and exp check at 5210'.
