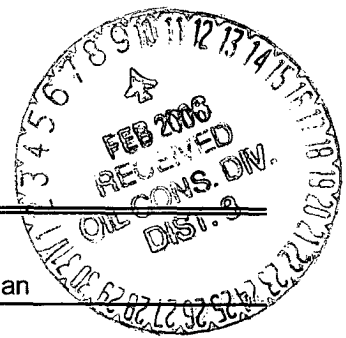

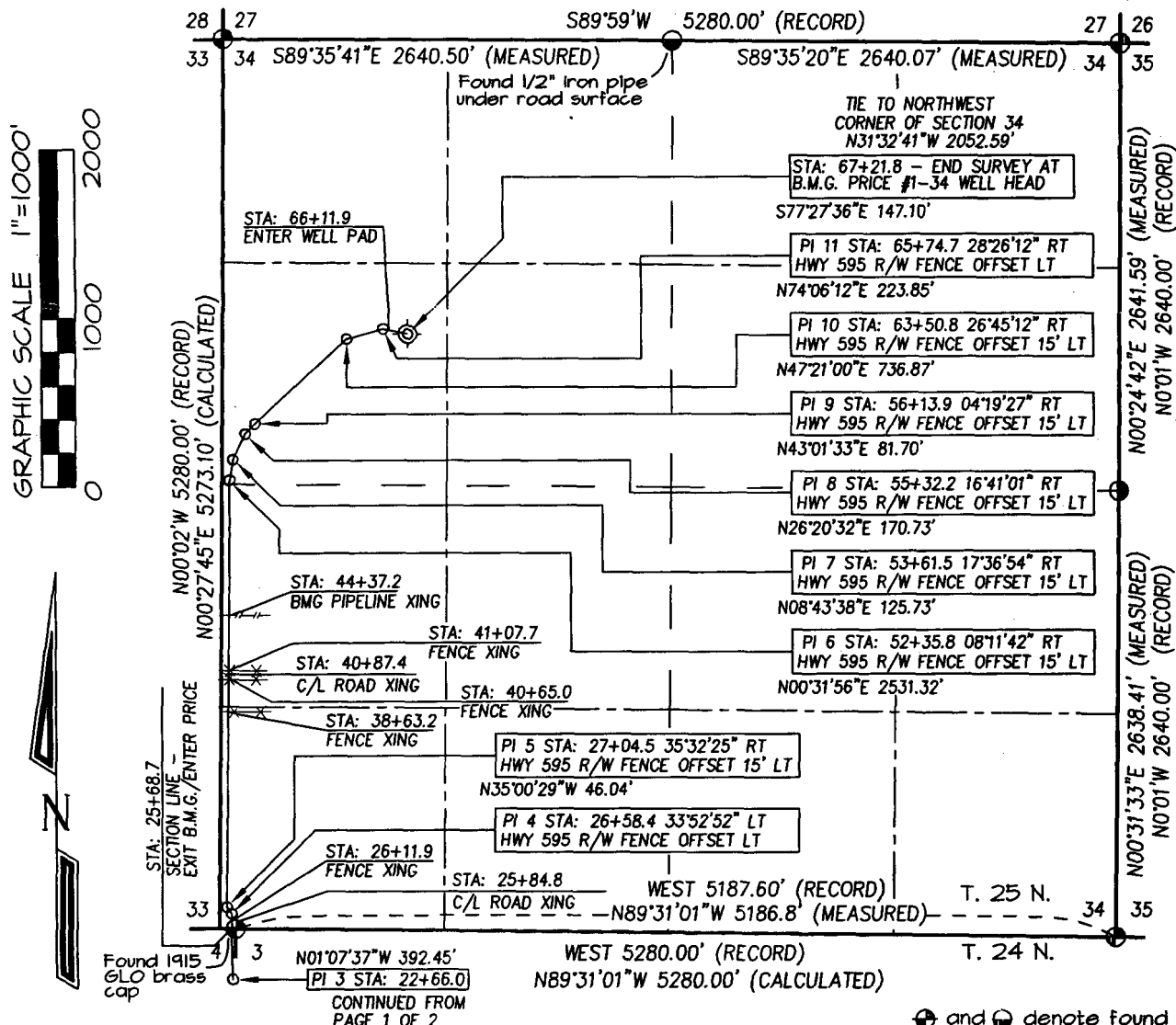

1. SITE PROTECTION AND EMPLOYEE EDUCATION: All employees of the project will be informed that cultural sites are to be avoided by all personnel, personal vehicles and company equipment. They will also be notified that it is illegal to collect, damage, or disturb cultural resources.

2. MONITORING IS REQUIRED. A copy of these stipulations will be supplied to the archeological monitor at least two working days prior to the start of construction activities. No construction activities, including vegetation removal, may begin before the arrival of the monitor.

The monitor will:

- * Ensure that the reroute is located at least 8' northwest of the original pipeline centerline extending from BOL to ES 3+50.
- * Ensure that the site protection barrier is located as indicated on the attached map.
- * Observe all surface disturbing activities within 100 feet of site LA 54315.
- * Submit a report of the monitoring activities within 30 days of completion of monitoring unless other arrangements are made with the BLM. These Stipulations must be attached to the report.

3. SITE BARRIER:

* A temporary site protection barrier will be erected prior to any construction. The barrier will consist of upright wooden survey lath spaced no more than 10 feet apart and marked with blue flagging or blue paint. There will be no construction activities or vehicle traffic past the barrier. The barrier will remain in place through reclamation and reseeding. The barrier will be promptly removed after reclamation.

- * The barrier will be placed as indicated on the attached map.

LA 54315: The barrier will be placed along the original pipeline centerline extending from ES 0+00 to ES 3+00.
