You submitted an APD on December 4, 2008, and was approved on August 12, 2010. The Approved Application for permit to Drill expired on August 12, 2014 and is rescind effective September 4, 2015.

If you wish to drill this well at some later date, please re-file your complete application.

Such a request, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, P.O. Box 27115, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87502-0115. Such a request will not result in a suspension of the instructions, orders, or decisions unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from the instructions, orders, or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 et. Seq
