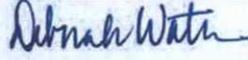

Rock basket cracked while transfer pump was in operation, produced water spilled from crack in rock basket. Spill was stopped and a water truck was brought in to recover produced water on January 14, 2016.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

- A water truck recovered 10 bbls of produced water.
- Fluids remained within secondary containment, all released produced water remained on the well pad.
- One five point composite confirmation sample will be collected from within secondary containment. The sample will be laboratory analyzed for BTEX, TPH (GRO/DRO), and chlorides.
- Additional cleanup actions will be taken if analytical laboratory results exceed NMOCD action levels based on site ranking.
