Directions from the Intersection of US Hwy 64 & US Hwy 550 in Bloomfield, NM to

Burlington Resources Oil & Gas Company San Juan 30-6 Unit #466S

1100' FSL & 1235' FEL, Section 22, T30N, R7W, N.M.P.M., Rio Arriba County, NM

From the intersection of US Hwy 64 & US Hwy 550 in Bloomfield, NM, travel Easterly on US Hwy 64 for 24.0 miles to State Hwy 539;

Go left (Northerly) on State Hwy 539 for 2.2 miles to the road to Smith Pass;

Go right (North-easterly) on the road to Smith Pass for 2.2 miles;

Go left (North-westerly) for 1.1 miles to the Smith Pass summit;

Go left which is straight (North-easterly) for 0.8 miles to fork in road;

Go right (South-easterly) for 0.3 miles to fork in road;

Go right (South-easterly) for 1.0 miles to staked location which overlaps an existing wellpad.
