Gentleman:

On January 9, 2014 the Farmington Field Office, Bureau of Land Management conducted a field inspection on the Martin #1, 1650FSL & 1650FWL, Section 34, T30N. R11W, lease number SF-080956 to evaluate the success of the final reclamation for this well site. According to our records this well was plugged on December 27, 1993. Conditions of Approval (COA's) attached to the approved Notice Of Intent to Abandon required that the well location and access road be reclaimed within one year of the plugging date. The results of our inspection are as follows:

- 1) No contouring of location
- 2) No apparent disking or seeding
- 3) Gravel and debris on portions of this location.



