Gentleman:

On June 5, 2014 the Farmington Field Office, Bureau of Land Management conducted a field inspection on the Hagood 30, 790FNL & 790FEL, Section 34, T29N, R13W, lease number NMNM-0468128 to evaluate the success of the final reclamation for this well site. According to our records this well was plugged on July 7, 2010. Conditions of Approval (COA's) attached to the approved Notice of Intent to Abandon required that the well location and access road be reclaimed within one year of the plugging date. We are sending back to you the Sundry Notice requesting a FAN on this well because of the following inspection results:

- 1) Very little desirable vegetation and non-native gravel on location.
- 2) Erosion on cut slope.
- 3) Access road has not been reclaimed and has halogeton present.

Please notify this office after remedial actions have been performed.
