13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operation: Clearly state all pertinent details, including estimated starting date of any proposed work and approximate duration thereof. If the proposal is to deepen directionally or recompleate horizontally, give subsurface locations and measured and true vertical depths of all pertinent markers and zones. BP proposes to continue operations at the well loaction and approximately 550' east of the well to the private landowner access point for the Jacquez Com 005 during the winter months. The main access for the location is to exit off US Highway 550 east onto Hart Canyon Rd. and travel approximately 7.3 miles to the site. The final 0.75 miles of this route is subject to coverage under this Sundry. Attached is an aerial with the route depicted. Heavy and ongoing precipitation, along with warm temperatures, has created undesirable conditions of the access roads. The road conditions have created ruts >6" in depth. BP will maintain the roads to access the site with a road maintainer, import fill material as needed and maintain soil on the roadway; soil will not be pushed off the existing shoulders of the road. BP will remain compliant with BLM H-9113-2 Level 3 road requirements. Once the weather permits, the road will be improved to pre-damaged conditions or better.



Stipulations for BP Sundry Barrett LS 001B. Schedule only essential water hauling on the freeze or defer this type of activity until it is absolutely necessary. Operators are advised to contact water haul vendors to properly schedule these activities. Some operators have requested exceptions, and received approval, to delay tank gauging activities until the road conditions improve. Water truck activity is the most destructive heavy road use operation occurring during this time period.

Curtail or defer all work-over activity if inclement weather is forecasted or expected to continue for an extended period of time. If work-over activity is absolutely necessary a sundry notice must be submitted in accordance with 3162.3-2, Subsequent Well Operations and 3162.3-3 Other Lease Operations. These actions need approval prior to commencing operations.
