
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Pulled the fiberglass BGT at the Albright 11 for upgrade to the steel pit tank for upcoming frac work and discovered impacted soil beneath tank. Contacted NMOCD to request a 5-point composite sample to be taken.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Impacted soil removal begin on 11/29. Results from the 5-point composite were unfavorable so HEC continued excavating the visually impacted soil. Thursday Rule Engineering was called to the site to help with the delineation and field testing. Excavation to favorable field results was completed on Thursday 11/30 late afternoon and confirmation sampling was scheduled for Monday 12/4.
