The original permit issued for salt-water disposal into the Point Lookout formation (Administrative Order #861) called for perforations from 3830-3845.

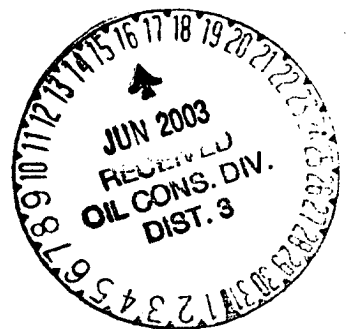
Calpine proposes to change the perforated interval to 3830-3900. The new perforations will still be in the Point Lookout formation.

You were previously notified via certified mail (letter dated 11/12/02) of Calpine's intent to re-enter the former Meridian Oil Company McCord #10. The well is now named the Calpine SWD #1. The procedure called for Calpine to drill out cement plugs, then complete the well for produced water disposal in the Point Lookout formation. The original application called for the Point Lookout to be perforated from 3830-3845. Calpine is proposing to alter the perforation interval to 3830-3900. The proposed perforations will still be in the Point Lookout formation.
