Originally planned to access the well via 1.4 miles of coal haul road. BLM approved that route in the APD (January 25) and in the BLM right-of-way (April 28). BHP subsequently denied Pogo longitudinal use of the coal haul road, but will allow Pogo to cross the road. As a result, Pogo will go west from its LaPlata 8-2 well along its existing gas pipeline.

Road has changed from ~4,000' long right-of-way (NMNM-115466) and ~300 yards on lease to 2,620.89' long right-of-way and 1,389.59' on lease. Right-of-way acres changed from 2.75 acres to 2.41 acres. No change in width (40'). Archaeology report WAS 5147A (April 28) covers change.

Road will be built to BLM Gold Book standards. Maximum cut or fill will be 10'. Maximum finished grade will be 10%. Culverts will be installed in coal haul road borrow ditches. Low water crossings will be built with an excavated material set above high water line. Cattle guards will be installed in the coal haul road fences.

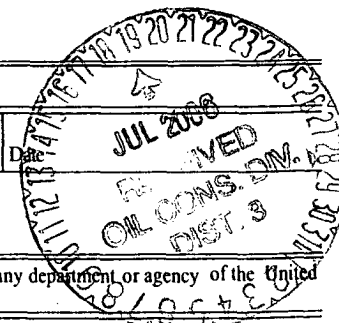

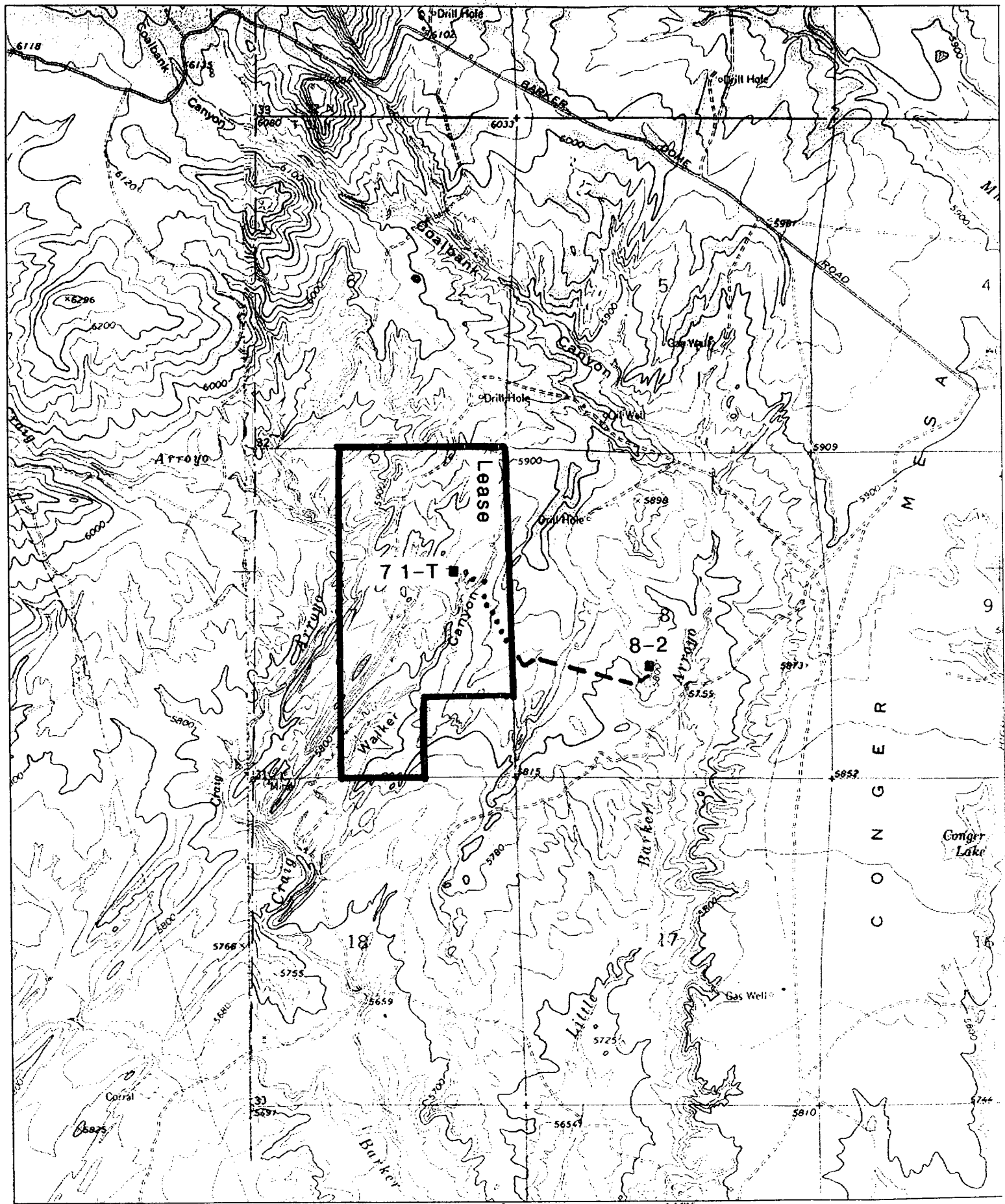
