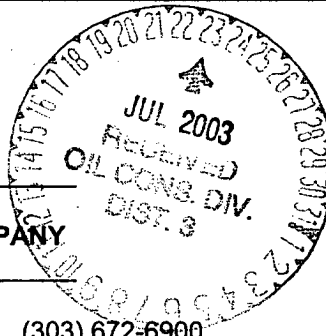

Questar Exploration request the **following revisions** to the approved October 30, 2001 Sundry Notice to P&A this well. A review of the well records report 85 bbls of cement slurry were circulated to the surface during the second stage cement job on March 9, 1990.

Therefore it is not necessary to perforate and squeeze cement outside the 4-1/2" casing at: **3790', 2286', 1804' and 360'** as specified in the approved Sundry.
