I refer to oil and gas prospecting permit Santa Fe 047584, issued June 24, 1925, to Calvin Arthur Terwilliger, assigned to Howard N. Longfellow, September 6, 1927, and canceled March 30, 1933.

Records of the Geological Survey disclose that one well has been drilled on the permit area in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 8, T. 30 N., R. 9 W., N.M.M., and that the satisfactory abandonment of the well was approved January 29, 1934.

The records also show that there was filed with your office an assignee's bond in the sum of \$1,000 executed July 19, 1927, by Howard N. Longfellow, as principal, and Royal Indemnity Company, as surety, to cover operations conducted on land included in permit Santa Fe 047584.

In view of the satisfactory abandonment of the one well drilled under this permit, the Geological Survey offers no objection to release of liability under the bond filed with the permit and recommends that the surety on the above mentioned bond be so advised. Please furnish the Geological Survey with copies of any letters to the surety company.
