### APPLICATION OF COLEMAN OIL & GAS, INC. FOR PRODUCED WATER DISPOSAL, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

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Under the provisions of Rule 701(B), Coleman Oil & Gas, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for permission to utilize for produced water disposal its Juniper West SWD Well No. 1 (API No. 30-045-33771) located 700 feet from the South line and 1715 feet from the West line of Section 24, Township 24 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

#### THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:

- (1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations;
- (2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified;
- (3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met; and
  - (4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The applicant is hereby authorized to utilize its Juniper West SWD Well No. 1 (API No. 30-045-33771) located 700 feet from the South line and 1715 feet from the West line of Section 24, Township 24 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such manner as to permit the injection of produced water for disposal purposes into the Menefee and Point Lookout members of the Mesaverde formation through perforations from approximately 2310 feet to 3565 feet and through plastic-lined tubing set in a packer located within 100 feet of the top of the injection interval.

The operator shall submit monthly reports of the disposal operations on Division Form C-115, in accordance with Rule Nos. 706 and 1120 of the Division Rules and Regulations.

The injection authority granted herein shall terminate one year after the effective date of this order if the operator has not commenced injection operations into the subject well, provided however, the Division, upon written request by the operator, may grant an extension thereof for good cause shown.
