

XTO had a previously approved permit on this location, but due to down spacing moved the location to accommodate the new spacing order. Since it was such a large move, the BLM requested that XTO submit a new APD and the old A #35 permit would be rescinded. A new APD was submitted under the name of the Ute Indians A #35 but for clarification purposes, the BLM has requested we change the name since a new API number will be assigned.
