DETAILS OF WORK

We Propose To:

1. Set cement plug in open hole from T.D. of 2074' up into 5 1/2" casing at 1549.
2. Cut off 5 1/2" casing at lowest free point. Spot cement plug from 50 ft. inside 5 1/2" stub to 50 ft. above 5 1/2" stub using approx. 35 sacks cement.
3. Fill open hole with mud to surface pipe.
4. Set 10 sacks cement plug in top of surface pipe. Erect regulation marker and permanently abandon well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
