NM&O is requesting an Onsite Landfarm or biopile as part of our corrective action plan, to remediate the contaminated soil from the release that occurred on 8/6/07. The landfarm/Biopile will be adequately bermed to contain any runoff fluids. The contaminated soil will be turned at a minimum once a month. Any standing fluids will be removed within 72 hours. The landfarm will be tested quarterly at a minimum until closure status can be reached. The soil will not be transferred off site without the OCD's approval. No additional soils will be added to the landfarm/ biopile other than what was excavated due to the above mentioned release without the OCD's approval. We have acquired the Landowners approval for the onsite remediation. Once the soil has reached closure status we will place it back on the well site.
