1. June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2007, MIRU, P&P Plugging CO. Nowata, Ok.
2. Circulated hole clean to Total Depth of 1599'
3. **Plug # 1-** Pumped 44 sks from 1599' to 1211'
4. **Plug #2-** Perforated squeeze holes at 695' into 5 ½" casing. Attempted circulation from 695' to surface. Could not establish circulation. Perforated squeeze holes @ 75'. Established circulation pumped 154 sks cement from 695' through squeeze holes at 75' around and to surface.
5. Allowed cement to stabilize, cut off casings.
6. June 29<sup>th</sup>, 2007, Pluggers MOL.
7. Restored location to BLM specifications
