13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

Burlington Resources was not able to test the packer. A hole was found between 3716' & 3777'. This is approximately 200' above the top MV perfs at 3974', top of MV is 3806'. Lewis @ 3700'. PTcsg to 500# & lost 160# per 20 min. Per Jim Lovato (BLM) Charca is below producing line and requires isolation.

Will get an injection rate, if greater than 1/4 bbl per min, we will attempt to convention cement squeeze and adjust the cement accordingly. If injection rate is less then 1/4 bbl per min, will attempt to inject 300psi product to seal off the leak. If the polymer product is required it will be several weeks before we can seal off the leak.
