13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations (Clearly state all pertinent dates, including estimated date of starting any proposed well is directionally drilled, give subsurface locations and measured and true vertical depths for all markers and zones pertinent to the well.)

Plans are to bury a #2 and a #8 gauge cathodic cable 12 to 18 inches in the ground from a proposed cathodic cable located in the SE1/4 NE1/4, Sec. 2, T.30 N., R.7 W to the NEBU 14A well location, as shown on the attached map. The purpose of this undertaking is to provide cathodic protection for the NEBU 14A well casing. The cable will be routed parallel to an existing El Paso Natural Gas pipeline and will be 10 to 15 feet from the pipeline. No right-of-way clearing will be required and the cable will be plowed in with the use of a ripper tooth on a ditch witch. All surface disturbance will be confined to the existing 50 foot right-of-way. The project will be on State lands and will be approximately 1,435. feet in length.

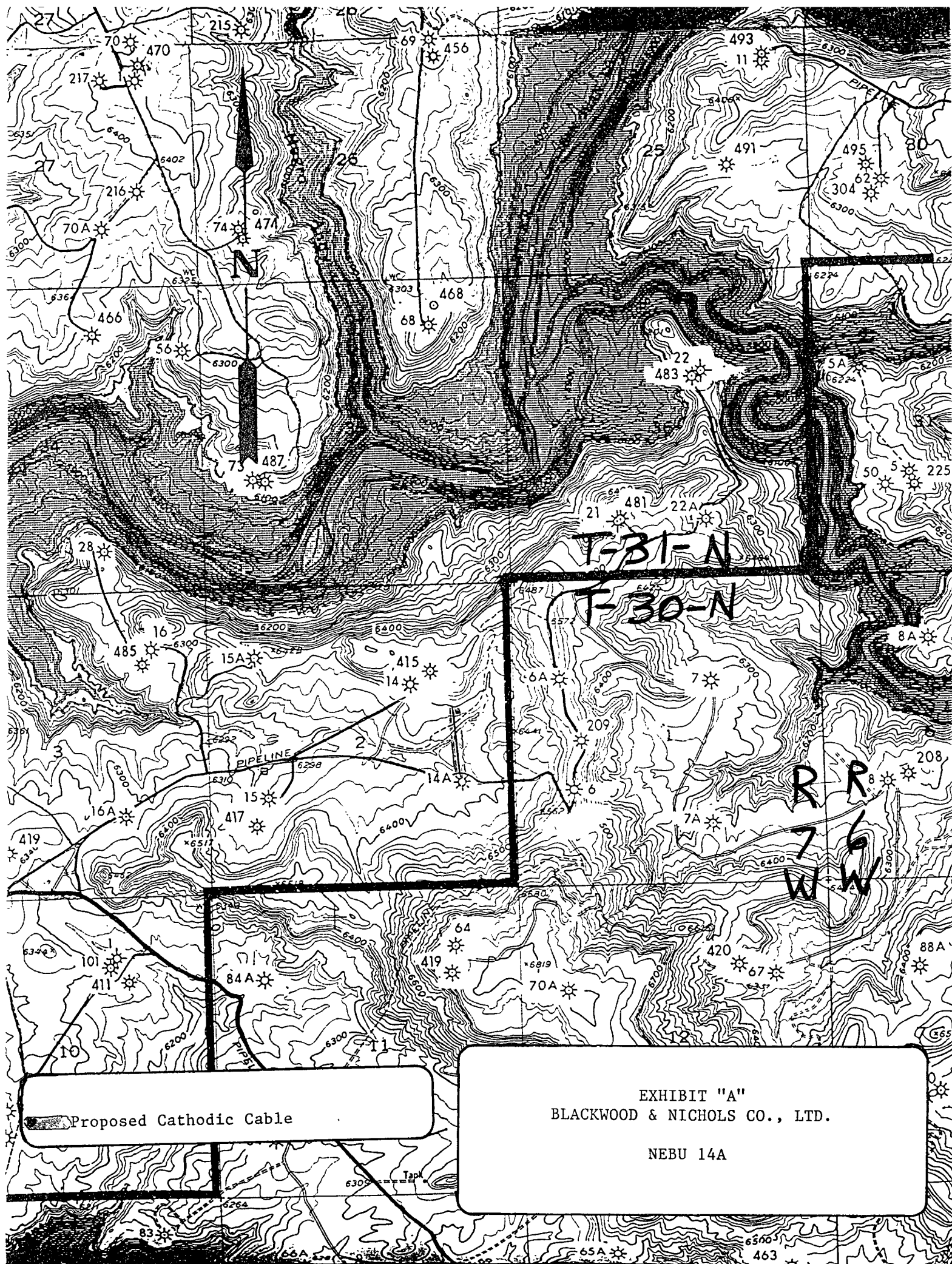
