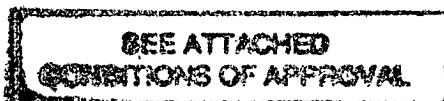

Temporary Abandonment: Conditions of Approval:

1. Approval for Temporary Abandonment is granted for a period of 12 months and will expire on August 15, 2008. This is 12 months from the first extended expiration date.
2. At the end of this Temporary Abandonment extension, please notify this office of your plans for this well. At the conclusion of the 12 month extension period, please resubmit form 3162-5 for consideration of continued Temporary Abandonment approval. At this time wellbore integrity testing may be required.
3. Provide to this office any or all shut-in pressures that may have monitored for this wellbore. Provide corrections for fluid level if available.
4. Provide to this office a current wellbore diagram. The latest wellbore diagram shows that pumping equipment is still installed in the wellbore. For this well to remain in TA status, a bridge plug may have to be set above the perforations and an appropriate wellhead be placed.
