**BACKGROUND:**

As discussed in recent phone conversation, BLM has concerns over resource damage on the Ute Mountain Ute Indian Reservation as Trustee of the Indian Minerals program including access to and from gas wells.

The Sundry Notice of Intent received February 15, 2008 requesting permission to tow vehicles in and out of the above mentioned well with crawlers due to frozen and icy road conditions as discussed is approved with the following

**CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL:**

1. Leases grant oil and gas operators the right to utilize existing or on-lease new approved roads to access mineral interests.
2. If roads are frozen as described and slippery, you have the authority to move equipment using crawlers if necessary. This should not noticeably degrade the roads
3. As discussed, if resource damage is being caused as in creating ruts deeper than 4" due to muddy conditions, action should cease until conditions permit access/egress without incurring damage to roads and adjacent resource areas.
4. Roads may be improved at the operator's discretion and expense to enable travel without incurring damage including the addition of rock and gravel in soft areas.
