300' of 10-5/4" OD 32.75# H-40 casing with 250 sacks regular cement, to be circulated.

6400' of 9-1/2" OD 15.5# J-55 casing with 450 sacks regular cement.

The designated drilling unit is the SE/4-SE/4 of Section 32-25N-5W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

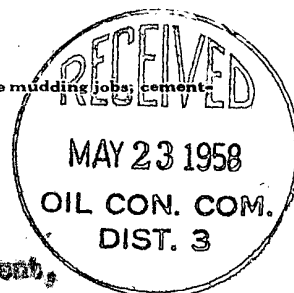
