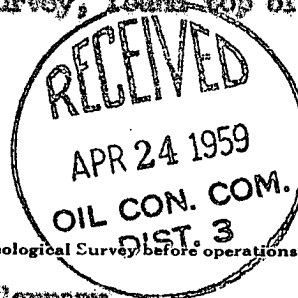

DETAILS OF WORK

Drilled to 5080' KB TD. Conditioned hole and ran 157 joints - 5080' casing, equipped with centralizers, scratchers and Baker float equipment. Casing landed at 5078' KB and cemented with 100 ss 50-50 pozzin with 2% gel. Pumped 10% solution of magcophos ahead of cement. Displaced cement to 5007' KB. Dumped plug with 1500 psi. Ran temperature survey, found top of cement at 4740' KB.
