Reference is made to your Application for Permit to Drill (APD) the **No. 100 Blanco 30 -12** well, located **1910' FSL and 1460' FWL, Section 10, T30N, R12W, San Juan County, New Mexico**. This APD was approved on February 23, 2005 with an expiration date of February 22, 2007. According to our records, no known activity has taken place at this location. On April 10, 2008, we received a new APD for the subject well replacing the expired permit referenced above. This APD is currently undergoing a technical and administrative review.

In view of the foregoing, this office is rescinding the approval due to the expiration of this APD. In addition, we will require a letter confirming that no surface disturbing activities have been conducted at this well site. Any surface disturbance conducted must be rehabilitated in accordance with the standards and guidelines established by this office.
