Proposed operations (as typed on document): "While stripping the location in preparation for drilling on the subject well's location, we encountered a section of historical hydrocarbon contaminated soil that we wish to obtain approval to remove. The soils will be excavated and taken to a commercial landfarm. Once the soil has been excavated will know more on the exact cubic feet to be taken to landfarm."

Conditions of Approval:

Soils used to replace the contaminated native soil shall be similar in composition.

After the proposed activities stated on the sundry notice are complete the operator shall provide the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) with a Subsequent Report of Operations (Form 3160-5) which includes:

1. Quantity of soils removed from the location.
2. Name and address of the landfarm location where contaminated soil was disposed.
3. Bill of receiving from the landfarm facility which, among other data, includes the date, quantity, and contaminant type of contaminated soil received.
4. Location (¼ ¼ TRS) and name of property owner from which clean soils were removed to replace removed contaminated soil at this well pad.

The Subsequent Report of Operations shall be received by the BLM within 20 days of activity completion.
