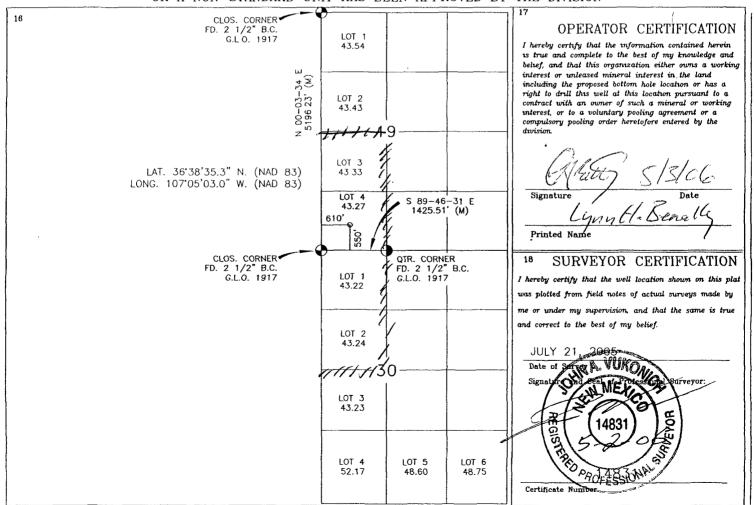

DRILLING PROGRAM

This Application for Permit to Drill (APD) was initiated under the NOS process as stated in Onshore Order No. 1 and supporting Bureau of Land Management (BLM) documents. This NOS process included an onsite meeting, which was held on March 29, 2006, as determined by Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) and Jicarilla Oil and Gas Administration (JOGA), and at which time the specific concerns of Black Hills Gas Resources, Inc. (Black Hills), BIA and JOGA were discussed.

All fresh water and prospectively valuable minerals encountered during drilling, will be recorded by depth and protected.

PRESSURE CONTROL

BOPs and choke manifold will be installed and pressure tested before drilling out under surface casing (subsequent pressure test will be performed whenever pressure seals are broken), and then will be checked daily as to mechanical operating condition. BOP's will be pressure tested at least once every 30 days. Ram type preventors and related pressure control equipment will be pressure tested to 1,000 psi. Annular type preventor will be pressure tested to 50% of the rated working pressure, not to exceed 1,000 psi. All casing strings will be pressure tested to 0.22 psi/ft. or 1,000 psi, whichever is greater, not to exceed 70% of internal yield.

BOP to be either double gate rams or an annular preventor as per Onshore Order No. 2.

Statement on Accumulator System and Location of Hydraulic Controls

The drilling rig has not yet been selected for this well. Selection will take place after approval of this application. Manual and/or hydraulic controls will be in compliance with Onshore Order No. 2 for 2M systems.

A remote accumulator will be used. Pressures, capacities, location of remote hydraulic and manual controls will be identified at the time of the BLM supervised BOP test.

COMPLETION

The location pad will be of sufficient size to accommodate all completion activities and equipment. A string of 2-3/8" J-55 4.7#/ft tubing will be run for a flowing string. A Sundry Notice will be submitted with a revised completion program if warranted.

Hydrogen Sulfide Drilling Operations Plan

Hydrogen Sulfide Training

All personnel, whether regularly assigned, contracted, or employed on an unscheduled basis, will receive training from a qualified instructor in the following areas prior to commencing drilling operations on this well:

- 1. The hazards and characteristics of hydrogen sulfide (H_2S) .
- The proper use and maintenance of personal protective equipment and life support systems.
- 3. The proper use of H₂S detectors, alarms, warning systems, briefing areas, evacuation procedures, and prevailing winds.
- 4. The proper techniques for first aid and rescue procedures.

In addition, supervisory personnel will be trained in the following areas:

- 1. The effects of H₂S on metal components. If high tensile tubulars are to be used, personnel will be trained in their special maintenance requirements.
- 2. Corrective action and shut-in procedures when drilling or reworking a well and blowout prevention and well control procedures.
- 3. The contents and requirements of the H₂S Drilling Operations Plan and the Public Protection Plan.

There will be an initial training session just prior to encountering a known or probable H_2S zone (within 3 days or 500 feet) and weekly H_2S and well control drills for all personnel in each crew. The initial training session shall include a review of the site specific H_2S Drilling Operations Plan and the Public Protection Plan. This plan shall be available at the well site. All personnel will be required to carry documentation that they have received the proper training.

II. H₂S Safety Equipment and Systems

Note: All H₂S safety equipment and systems, if necessary, will be installed, tested, and operational when drilling reaches a depth of 500 feet above or three days prior to penetrating the first zone containing or reasonably expected to contain H₂S.

A. Well control equipment:

- 1. Choke manifold with a minimum of one remote choke.
- 2. Blind rams and pipe rams to accommodate all pipe sizes with properly sized closing unit.

- B. Protective equipment for essential personnel:
 - 1. Mark II Surviveair 30-minute units located in the doghouse and at briefing areas, as indicated on well site diagram.
- C. H₂S detection and monitoring equipment:
 - 1. Two portable H_2S monitors positioned on location for best coverage and response. These units have warning lights and audible sirens when H_2S levels of 10 ppm are reached.
- D. Visual warning systems:
 - 1. Wind direction indicators as shown on well site diagram.
 - Caution/Danger signs shall be posted on roads providing direct access to location. Signs will be painted a high visibility yellow with black lettering of sufficient size to be readable at a reasonable distance from the immediate location. Bilingual signs will be used when appropriate. See example attached.

E. Mud program:

1. The mud program has been designed to minimize the volume of H_2S circulated to the surface. Proper mud weight, safe drilling practices, and the use of H_2S scavengers will minimize hazards when penetrating H_2S bearing zones.

F. Metallurgy:

- 1. All drill strings, casings, tubing, wellhead, blowout preventors, drilling spools, kill lines, choke manifold and lines, and valves shall be suitable for H₂S service.
- 2. All elastomers used for packing and seals shall be H₂S trim.

G. Communication:

1. Cellular telephone communications in company vehicles.

H. Well testing:

 Drill stem testing will be performed with a minimum number of personnel in the immediate vicinity which are necessary to safely and adequately conduct the test. The drill stem testing will be conducted during daylight hours and formation fluids will not be flowed to the surface. All drill stem testing operations conducted in an H₂S environment will use the closed chamber method of testing.

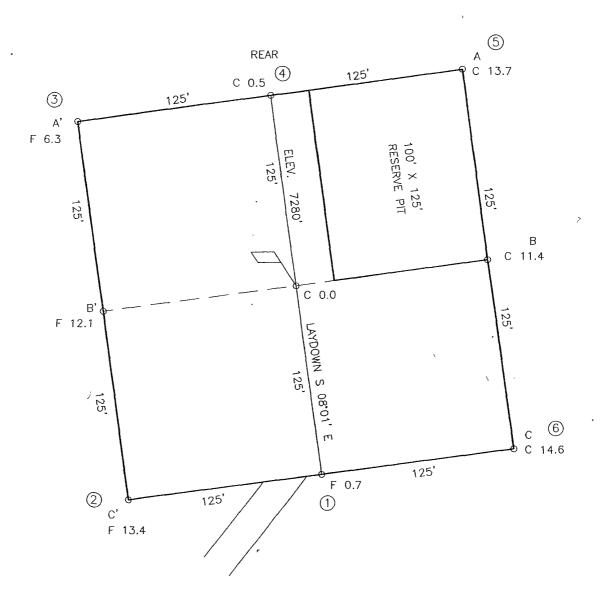

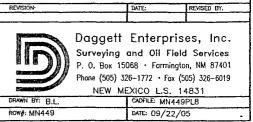

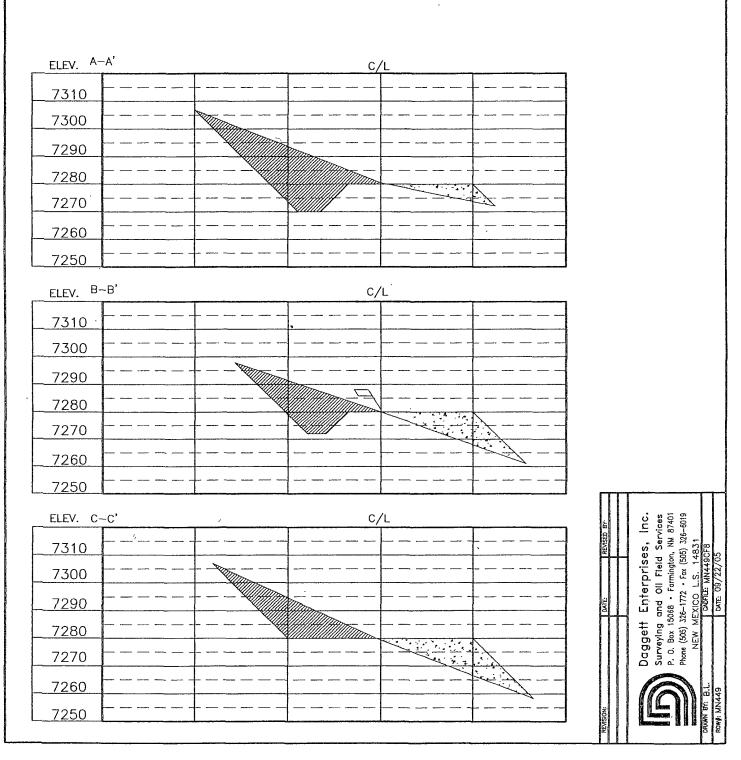
